RELM Wireless Receives Orders Totaling \$2.6 Million from Federal Agencies

WEST MELBOURNE, FL, October 2, 2007 – RELM Wireless Corporation (AMEX: RWC) today announced that it has received orders totaling \$2.6 million from agencies of the United States Federal Government. Approximately 86% of the orders are for P25-compliant, digital products, most of which were shipped during the third quarter of 2007. The balance of the orders is expected to ship during the fourth quarter of 2007.

“One of our primary objectives is to penetrate new federal government agencies,” commented RELM President and Chief Executive Officer David Storey. “These orders, which include business from new federal agencies, are an indication of RELM’s progress toward that objective, and demonstrate growing confidence in our products and services among agencies of the federal government. The products associated with these orders will be widely deployed, providing the reliable communications capabilities demanded by public safety and military professionals in critical situations. The foundation of RELM is built on understanding and meeting those demands.”

About APCO Project 25 (P25)

APCO Project 25 (P25), which requires interoperability among compliant equipment regardless of the manufacturer, was established by the Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials and is approved by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The shift towards interoperability has gained momentum as a result of communications failures such as those experienced during Hurricane Katrina, the 9/11 terrorist attacks and the Oklahoma City bombing. RELM was one of the first manufacturers to develop P25-compliant technology.
